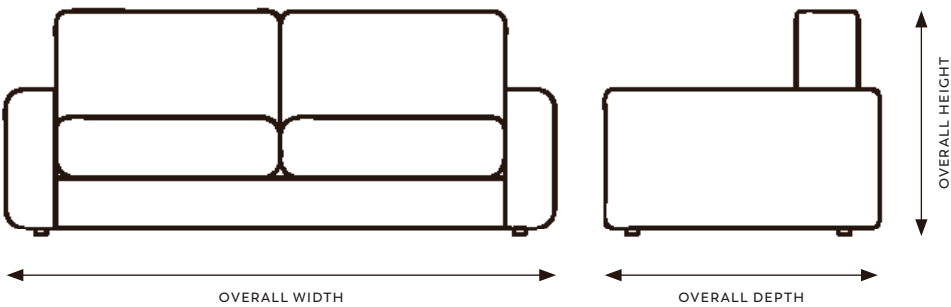


Furniture Measuring & Delivery Guide

CONFIRM PRODUCT DIMENSIONS

Find the width, depth, and height of the product on the item page. Furniture width must be less than the height of any doorway, stairway, or hallway the item will need to pass through. Furniture is measured at the tallest, deepest and widest points of the product, including overhangs, angles, outward curves and arms.

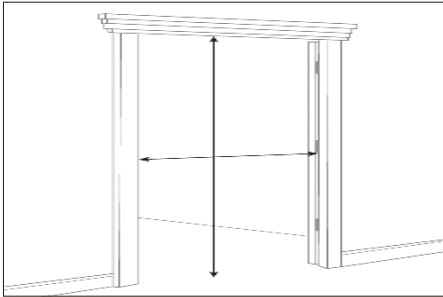
MEASURE THE SPACE

Identify where you intend to place your furniture and make sure it will fit in the space you've chosen. Consider marking the width and depth of your furniture on the floor with painter's tape.

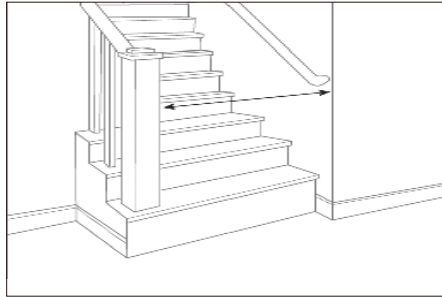
Determine the best pathway from outside your home to the room where your furniture will be placed. Measure each doorway, elevator, staircase, and hallway the item will pass through. Compare these measurements to the dimensions of the product to ensure it can fit through entryways and around obstacles.

DOORWAYS



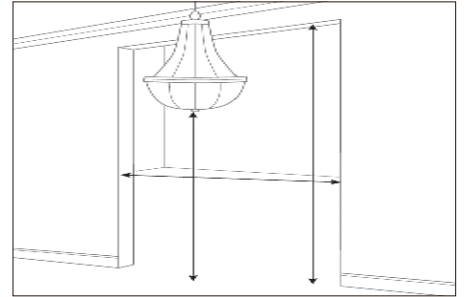
Measure the interior width and height of all doorways.
Check how wide doors can open
Check for architectural details that may impede access.

STAIRWAYS



Measure the width, taking handrails into account.
Measure the height from the top and bottom steps to the ceiling.
Make sure the item can fit on and around any landings.

HALLWAYS



Measure the width of hallways, taking any twists or turns into account.
Check for architectural details or low-hanging fixtures that may impede access.
