
Furniture Measuring & Delivery Guide



CONFIRM PRODUCT DIMENSIONS

Check the item page on the website for the product's width, depth, and height.

Measurements include the tallest, deepest, and widest points, accounting for any overhangs, angles, curves, or arms (see below).





2 MEASURE THE SPACE

Identify where you want to place your furniture and make sure it will fit in the space you've chosen. Consider marking the width and depth of your furniture on the floor with painter's tape.



MEASURE THE PATH FOR DELIVERY

Identify the best path from outside to the room where the furniture will be placed.

Measure each doorway, elevator, staircase, and hallway along the way, and compare these dimensions to the furniture. Ensure the furniture's height is less than the height of any entryway or passage it will need to pass through.

DOORWAYS




Measure doorway width and height.

Check how wide doors can open.

Identify architectural features that could obstruct access.

STAIRWAYS




Measure the interior width of the steps, taking handrails into account.

Measure the height from the top and bottom steps to the ceiling.

Ensure the item can fit around any twists, turns, and landings.

HALLWAYS



Measure the width of hallways, taking any twists or turns into account.

Check for architectural details and light fixtures that may obstruct access.
